



The RGSGQ Home-School Agreement 2022-2023

The RGSGQ will make every effort to ensure all pupils have the opportunity to realise their full potential. We believe that a partnership between home and school is essential if we are to realise that aim.

Parents and guardians who accept a place for their child at the RGSGQ undertake to uphold the school's policies and regulations. They will support the school's values in matters such as attendance and punctuality, behaviour, uniform and appearance, standards of academic work, extra-curricular activities and homework.

The RGSGQ considers the Home-School relationship between parents/legal guardians and the school to be crucial to the development and wellbeing of the pupils. Working in partnership with The RGSGQ can make an enormous difference to your child's happiness, wellbeing and progress.

In order to maintain good relations and communication at all times with the Principal, the Head of School and the RGSGQ staff, please kindly note the following requirements for parents/legal guardians and pupils, and sign this agreement.

The school commits to:

1. Provide a secure, happy and stimulating learning environment in which we encourage all pupils to do their best in all situations.
2. Provide a broad and balanced curriculum which challenges all pupils to fulfil their potential.
3. Provide parents with information about the curriculum.
4. Set appropriate homework.
5. Keep parents informed about their children's progress and alert them to potential problems.
6. Encourage pupils to show friendship towards and respect others.
7. Encourage pupils to adhere to school behaviour policies.
8. Welcome parents when they visit the school for a scheduled appointment and respond to enquiries or concerns in good time.
9. Keep parents informed about activities and events at school.
10. Provide a bundle of stationery at the beginning of every term to every pupil.

Parents commit to:

1. Accept the school's aims and values, and positively promote the school by following those values.
2. Ensure that their child arrive punctually every day and attends school every day the school is in session, unless there is a good reason for absence (e.g. illness). This means that family life and commitments, as well as medical appointments, must be managed in such a way that attendance at school takes priority.
3. Ensure that their child wears the uniform as per The RGSGQ expectations at all times.
4. Stay informed of and monitor the completion of homework to the expected standard and by the required deadline.
5. Abide by the school regulations relating to pupil drop-off, pick-up and security passes, and follow the instructions of our security team.
6. Attend all essential Parent/Teacher Meetings relating to the progress of their child; read pupil school reports as and when received throughout the academic year. Please note, it is not acceptable for a home representative such as a private tutor, personal assistant, nanny, maid or alternative family member to attend such meetings in place of the parent/legal guardian. The school will only communicate with the pupil's parent/s/legal guardian/s on school-related matters.
7. Support all the school policies, such as (but not limited to) behaviour, healthy eating, uniform and security.
8. Encourage their children to engage in extra-curricular activities and to fully support the House system.
9. Replace any library books which are damaged whilst in the possession of their child. Please note: the child will not be permitted to withdraw any further library books until an exact replacement of the damaged book has been received by the school.
10. Inform the school of any matters which may affect their children in school (such as medical concerns).
11. Inform the school promptly if their contact details change.
12. Provide the necessary stationery equipment to their children if the bundle given by the school to the pupils at the beginning of every term is not maintained or gets lost.
13. Abide by the timings of the school and do not take their child out of school before the scheduled end of the day (except under exceptional circumstances).
14. Be respectful towards staff and other parents at all times.
15. Not approach/speak to pupils who are not their own children on the school site.



Pupils commit to:

1. Follow the school rules and The RGSGQ Values at all times.
2. Display kindness, empathy, support and respect towards all at all times.
3. Act as an ambassador for The RGSGQ at all times and take pride in their school.
4. Take and accept responsibility for their actions.
5. Wear their uniform properly at all times, whether in or outside of school.
6. Do their best to attend school every day and be punctual.
7. Fully support their House.
8. Do their best in everything they do in school and complete all homework to the best of their ability on time.
9. Participate in the extra-curricular activities on offer.
10. Leave mobile phones switched off in their school bag during the school day from 07:30 until departing school (Senior School pupils only).
