Rationale

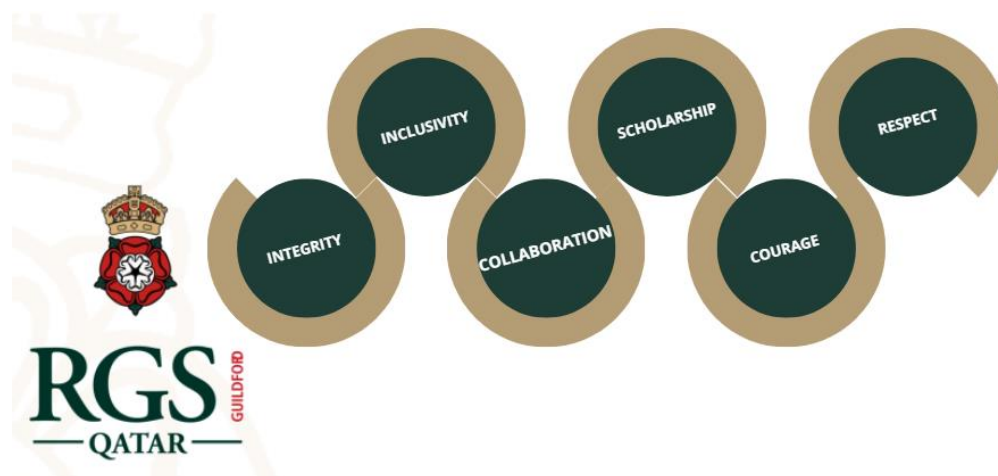
The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all members of staff are aware of the importance of The RGSGQ values within our practice and our community.

Scope

This procedure applies to all pupils in both Primary and Secondary Schools across The Royal Grammar School Guildford Qatar, and beyond, within the whole school community.

Policy Statement

Our core purpose is to ensure that every child or young adult, who comes through our doors, gains as much from the experience of being here as possible. We base this on our belief that all learners can, need and want to achieve. We will, therefore, provide the highest standards of teaching and learning together with substantive support for our RGSGQ values. We want our students to complete their education here as well-rounded individuals. We believe that The RGSGQ values are highly important, intrinsic to our work, and reflect and promote our school ethos and culture.



Implementation

Curriculum

- The RGSGQ values are embedded into schemes of work for all subjects.
- All staff are responsible for the development of students' character within their lessons.
- All staff should model the RGSGQ values within their own behaviour and the language they use.

Pastoral

- House assemblies and tutor time activities are linked to The RGSGQ values.
- Student Council and student leadership will give opportunities for students to develop, practise and deepen their RGSGQ values.
- The PSHE programme deepens our students' understand, practice and demonstration of The RGSGQ values.

Wider Curriculum

- The school's extensive Extra-Curricular Activities programme plays an integral part in the development of The RGSGQ values.
- The Duke of Edinburgh's award, Model United Nations and Eco Warriors all give students opportunities to develop their character in line with The RGSGQ values.
- Local and International trips are linked to the character development and The RGSGQ values.
